<b>Q. 9</b>	<p><i>What are angels?</i></p> <p><b>Angels are invisible spirits. They are God's helpers.</b></p> <p>(Catechism of the Catholic Church 328-30)</p>
<b>Q. 10</b>	<p><i>What makes you a human person?</i></p> <p><b>I am a human person because I have a body and a soul.</b></p> <p>(Catechism of the Catholic Church 366)</p>
<b>Q. 11</b>	<p><i>Will your soul ever die?</i></p> <p><b>No, my body will die, but my soul will live forever.</b></p> <p>(Catechism of the Catholic Church 362-65)</p>
<b>Q. 12</b>	<p><i>What must you do to gain the Happiness of Heaven?</i></p> <p><b>To gain the happiness of Heaven I must know, love and serve God in this world.</b></p> <p>(Catechism of the Catholic Church 202; Mk 2:30)</p>
