THE SEVEN DAYS OF CREATION

On The First Day of Creation (Gen 1:1-5)

1 In the beginning God created heaven, and earth. **2** And there was nothing on the earth, it was completely empty, and it was completely dark everywhere; and the whole of the earth was covered with water. **3** And God said: Be light made. And light was made. **4** And God saw the light was good; and he divided the light from the darkness. **5** And he called the light Day, and the darkness Night; and all this happened on the first day.

On The Second Day of Creation (Gen 1:6-8)

6 And God said: Let there be atmosphere and sky. **7** And God made the sky and the heavens and he put clouds and wind in the sky. **8** And God did all this on the second day.

On The Third Day of Creation (Gen 1:9-13)

9 God also said: let dry land appear. **10** And God called the dry land, earth; and the waters, He called seas. And God saw that it was good. **11** And he said: Let the earth bring forth the green plants. And it was so done. **12** And the earth brought forth the green plants, grass, trees, fruit to eat and lovely flowers. And God saw that it was good. **13** And all this happened on the third the third day.

On The Forth Day of Creation (Gen 1:14-19)

14 And God said: Let there be a sun and a moon in the sky, to divide the day and the night, and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days and years: **15** To shine in the sky, and to give light upon the earth. And it was so done. **16** And God made *two great lights*: a big sun to rule the day; and a small moon to rule the night: and God also made the stars. **17** And he put them in the sky to shine upon the earth. **18** And God saw that it was good. **19** And all this God did on the fourth day.

On The Fifth Day of Creation (Gen 1:20-23)

20 God also said: Let the seas and rivers and lakes bring forth the fish and other creature, and the birds that may fly over the earth in the sky. **21** And God created the great whales, and every living and moving creature in the water and sky. And God saw that it was good. **22** And he blessed them, saying: Increase and multiply, and fill the waters of the seas: and let the birds be multiplied upon the earth. **23** And all this happened on the fifth day.

On The Sixth Day of Creation (Gen 1:24-31)

24 And God said: Let the earth bring forth living creatures, cattle and insects, butterflys and mice, cats and dogs and every animal you can think off. And it was done. **25.** And God saw that it was good.

26 And he said: *Let us make man to our image* and likeness: and let him have power over the fishes of the sea, and the birds of the air, and all the animals, and the whole earth, and every creeping crawly on the earth. **27** And God created man in his own image: man and lady he made them. **28** And God blessed them, saying: *Increase and multiply*, and fill the earth, and subdue it, and rule over the fishes of the sea, and the birds of the air, and all living creatures that move upon the earth. **29** And God said: I have given you all the plants and food you need for your food: **31** And God saw all the things that he had made, and they were very good. And all this happened on the sixth day.


On The Sixth Day of Creation (Gen 2:1-3)

God our Father shows His love by caring for His children

- Q. 4** *What is Heaven?*
Heaven is God's home and a place of perfect happiness
(CCC 326, 1024)
- Q. 5** *Where is God?*
God is in Heaven, on Earth, and in every place (CCC 2794-96)
- Q. 6** *Can God do all things?*
Yes, God can do all things (CCC268-69)
- Q. 7** *Does God know all things?*
Yes, God knows all things, even our thoughts (CCC 305)
