Lesson 4	<b>Revision and Assessment</b>

### **AIMS**

To review and assess the child's knowledge of the first module, Our Heavenly Father

### **PREPARATION**

1. Make sure you preview the lesson before attempting to teach it.
2. Print out a children's pack for each child.
3. It may be worth considering laminating the Our Father.

### **STEP 1**

Begin the review by praying the Our Father together. Assess each child and assist them as needed.

### **STEP 2**

Revise the Catechism questions with the children:

### **STEP 3**

4. Explain that God loves everything that He has made, especially them
5. Remind them that each one of them is a child of God.
6. Tell them that they are all members of God's family.
7. Remind them how special everyone is because God loves each person, He cares for each person, He helps each person and He gives us all we need.

### **STEP 4**

#### **Play Telephone**

The children sit in a circle. The teacher whispers a sentence to the first child. That child then whispers it to the next child. The message continues round the circle until the last child, who then stands up and repeats it out loud to the entire group. If a child has difficulty with the message, he should say "operator" which means he needs the message repeated.

Some suggested telephone messages:

1. The Our Father is a prayer that Jesus gave us.
2. Prayer is talking to God
3. We are all brothers and sisters in our Heavenly Father's family

### **ASSESS**

1. Pass out Quizzes 1 and 2. Read through the quiz with them and answer any questions that they may have. When it is complete, correct the quizzes and hand them back and review them with the children.
2. Question the children again on the Catechism questions.

3. Say the Our Father again with the children.

**CONCLUDE**

Optionally: close the lesson by singing “God Father, Praise and Glory,” Adoramus Hymnal, #464
