Who, the day before He suffered, took bread into His Holy and venerable hands, and having lifted up His eyes to heaven, to Thee, God, His Almighty Father, giving thanks to Thee, blessed it ✠, broke it, and gave it to His disciples, saying:
Take and eat ye all of this:

FOR THIS IS MY BODY.

in like manner, after He had supped, taking also into His holy and venerable hands this goodly chalice, again giving thanks to Thee, He blessed it ✠, and gave it to His disciples, saying: Take and drink ye all of this:

FOR THIS IS THE CHALICE OF MY BLOOD, OF THE NEW AND ETERNAL TESTAMENT: THE MYSTERY OF FAITH: WHICH WILL BE SHED FOR YOU AND FOR MANY UNTO THE REMISSION OF SINS.

The special supper and religious service Jesus shared with His **Apostles** on the night before He died is called the **Last Supper**. At the Last Supper, Jesus took bread and blessed it. He said, "Take this and eat it. **This is My Body**." Then Jesus took a cup of wine and said, "**This is the cup of My Blood**." Jesus changed bread and wine into His own **Body** and **Blood**.

When the Apostles ate this Bread Jesus lived inside them. In this way, Jesus can be inside us and love us very much.

The Church calls this miracle of the changing of bread and wine into the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ "**Transubstantiation**."
