

Mary Nazareth Gabriel Jesus Joseph

THE ANNUNCIATION (LUKE 1:26-38)



When Elizabeth had been pregnant for six months with St John the Baptist, God sent the angel Gabriel to a city of Galilee called Nazareth, where a virgin lived, she was engaged to a man of David's family; his name was Joseph, and the virgin's name was Mary. The angel said to Mary, "Hail, you who are full of grace; the Lord is with you." She was very puzzled at hearing the Angel speak in this way, and cast about in her mind, what would you make such a greeting.

Then the angel said to her, "Mary, do not be afraid; you have pleased God. And behold, you shall conceive in your womb,
