THREE DIFFERENT ACCOUNTS OF THE LAST SUPPER

Matthew:

And whilst they were at supper, Jesus took bread, and blessed, and broke: and gave to his disciples, and said: Take ye, and eat. <u>This is my body</u>. And taking the chalice, he gave thanks, and gave to them, saying: <u>Drink ye all of this</u>. For this is my <u>blood of the new testament</u>, which shall be shed for many unto remission of sins. And I say to you, I will not drink from henceforth of this <u>fruit of the vine</u>, until that day when I shall drink it with you new in the kingdom of my Father. And a hymn being said, they went out unto mount Olivet.

Mark:

And whilst they were eating, Jesus took bread; and blessing, broke, and gave to them, and said: Take ye. This is my body. And having taken the chalice, giving thanks, he gave it to them. And they all drank of it. And he said to them: This is my blood of the new testament, which shall be shed for many. Amen I say to you, that I will drink no more of the fruit of the vine, until that day when I shall drink it new in the kingdom of God.

Luke:

And when the hour was come, he sat down, and the twelve apostles with him. [And he said to them: With desire I have desired to eat this pasch with you, before I suffer. For I say to you, that from this time I will not eat it, till it be fulfilled in the kingdom of God. And having taken the chalice, he gave thanks, and said: Take, and divide it among you: For I say to you, that I will not drink of the fruit of the vine, till the kingdom of God come. And taking bread, he gave thanks, and brake; and gave to them, saying: This is my body, which is given for you. *Do this for a commemoration of me*. In like manner the chalice also, after he had supped, saying: This is the chalice, the new testament in my blood, which shall be shed for you.


