DEATHS OF THE TWELVE APOSTLES

Simon Peter	Crucified upside down
Andrew	Crucified, but it was tied to the cross with ropes instead of nailed
James the greater	Killed by a sword
John	Died naturally in Ephesus at a very old age
Philip	Is believed to have been martyred, but the details are unknown
Thomas	Was killed with a spear
Bartholomew	He was either whipped to death, crucified head downwards or beheaded
Matthew	Burned, stoned or beheaded
James, son of Alpheus	He was killed by Jews
Jude Thaddeus	He was thrown off the top of the Temple and then beaten to death with a club. After he was dead, they cut off his head
Simon the Zealot	His body was sawn into pieces
Judas	The man who betrayed Christ, hanged himself
Matthias	The man chosen by the Apostles to replace Judas; he was either stoned to death or crucified by the Jews in Jerusalem. He was beheaded after it was dead.

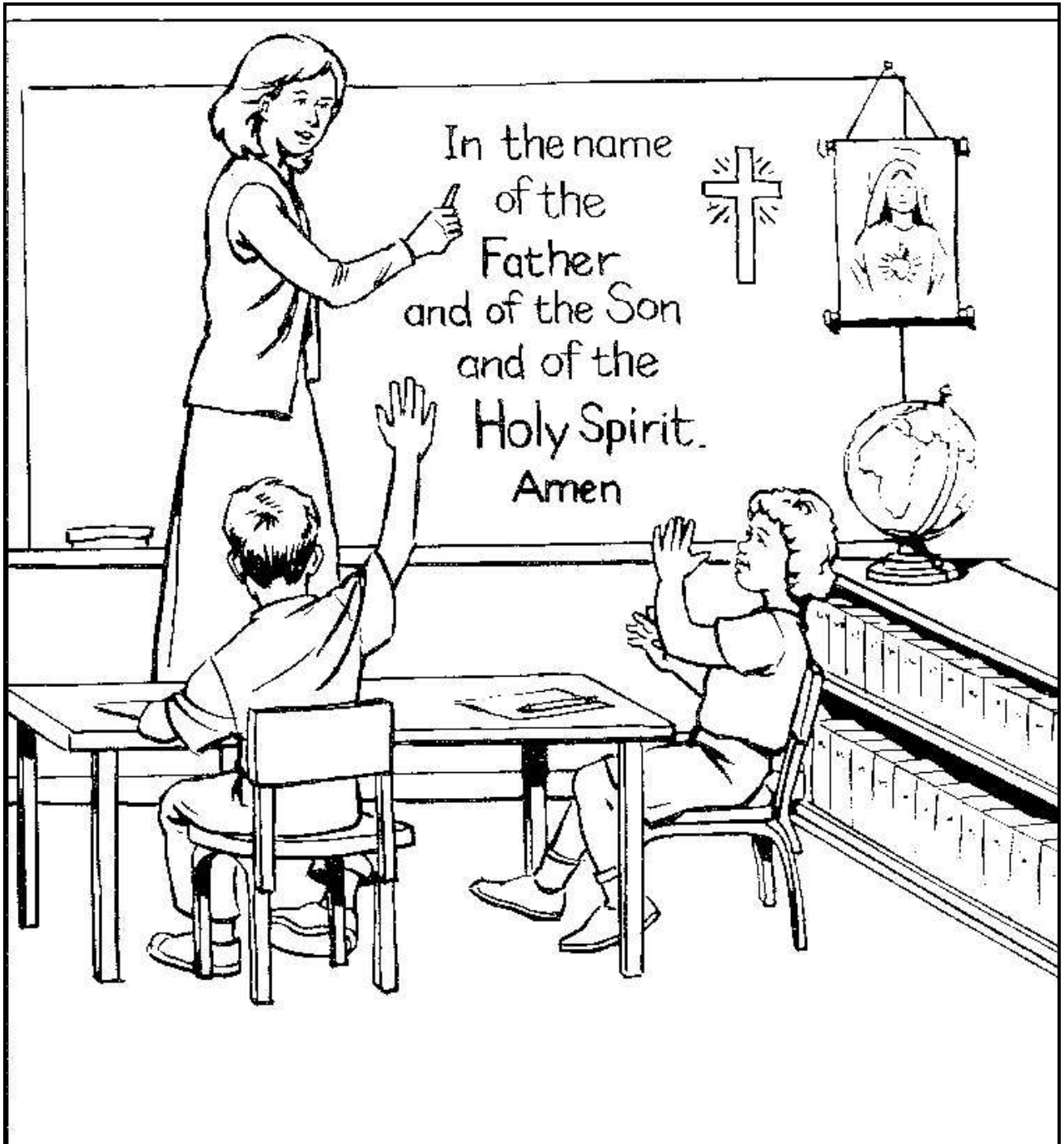
