SAINT BENEDICT AND THE SIGN OF THE CROSS




St Benedict was born into a noble family in modern-day Italy around the year 490. As a young man he was sent to Rome to go to school. But he didn't like school because many of the other young men were very naughty, so he left to become a hermit. He was soon discovered and asked to lead a group of monks. But he was so strict that some very bad monks mixed poison in his wine.

But St Benedict always said his grace before he eat or drank, so he made the Sign of the Cross over his wine. And do you know what happened? ... the cup smashed and so his life was saved! This story teaches us that the Sign of the Cross is a very powerful prayer.


St Benedict eventually founded famous monastery at Monte Cassino and wrote the rule of St Benedict. He died around 547. He is often called the Father ofWestern Monasticism. We celebrate his feast day on July 11.
